- Audit Scotland now reporting on outcomes on BV2 Pathfinders
- Road testing a new audit approach. Risk based/Self evaluation
- Pathfinder Councils:

- New Judgements “pace and direction of change” and “prospects for future improvement”

National Financial Issues



- Scottish Parliament Finance Committee – Budget Strategy Phase April/June 2010
- Remit:
 - “ What preparations should be underway now by the public sector to ensure the efficient delivery of public services within a period of tightening public expenditure?”
- Key Issues ranging from user involvement, ring fencing, organisation of public services and efficiency savings
- Outcome of Finance Committee, inform 2011/12 budget

Independent Budget Review



- Commissioned in February 2010 to conduct a review of public expenditure
- Will inform next spending review 2011-14
- Will make recommendations about options for delivering public services within constrained public expenditure
- Report in July 2010
