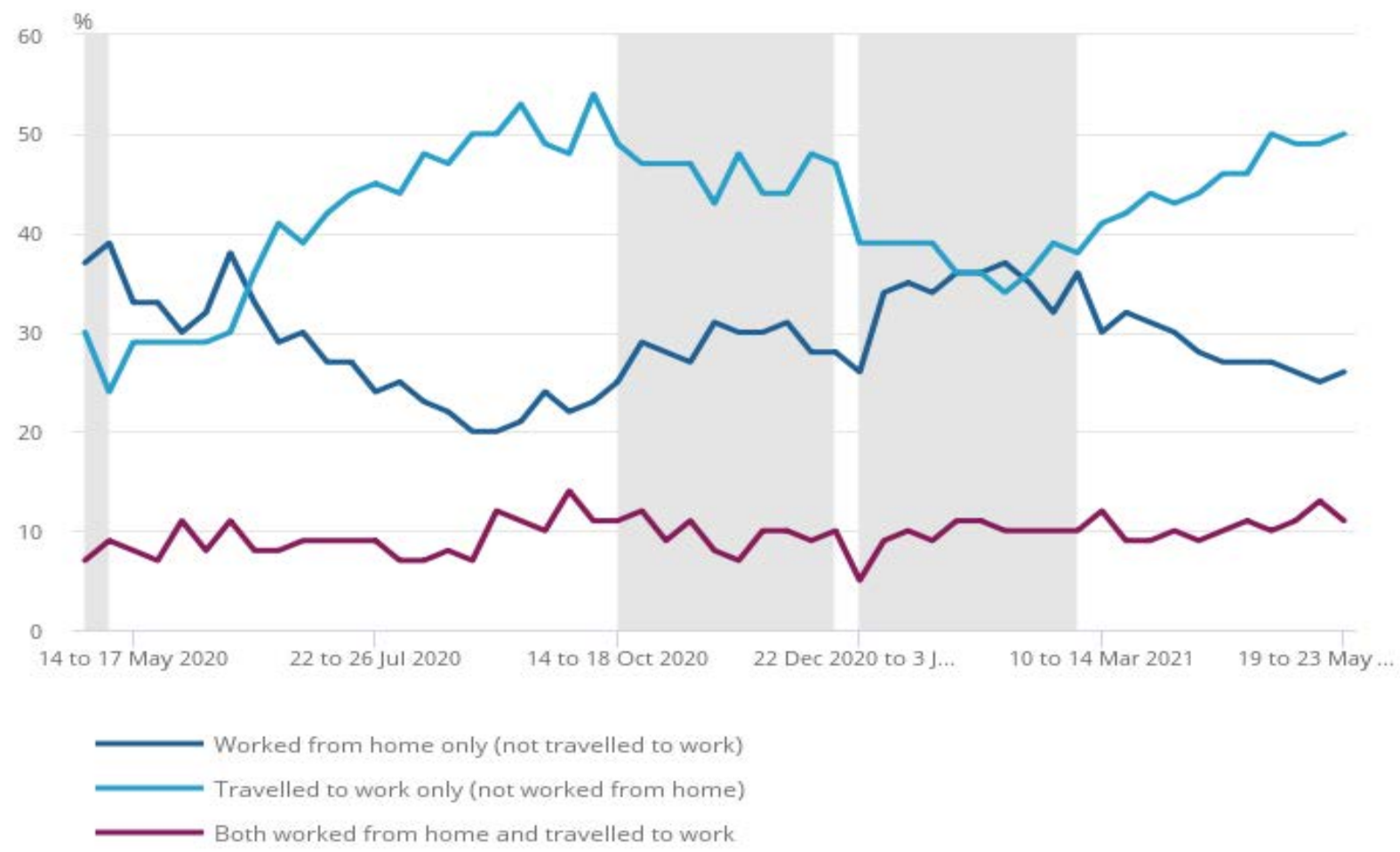

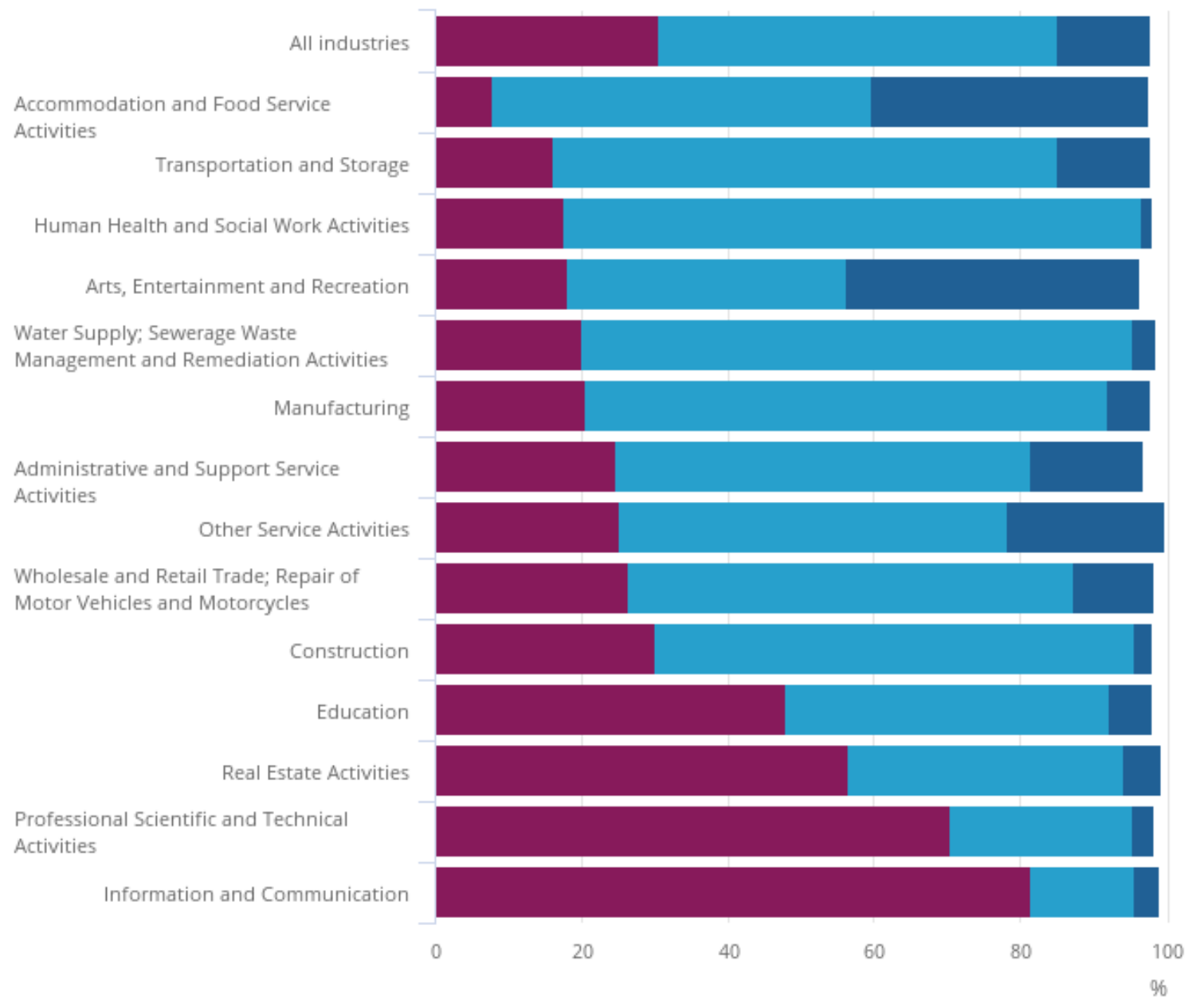

Working adults, Great Britain, May 2020 to May 2021

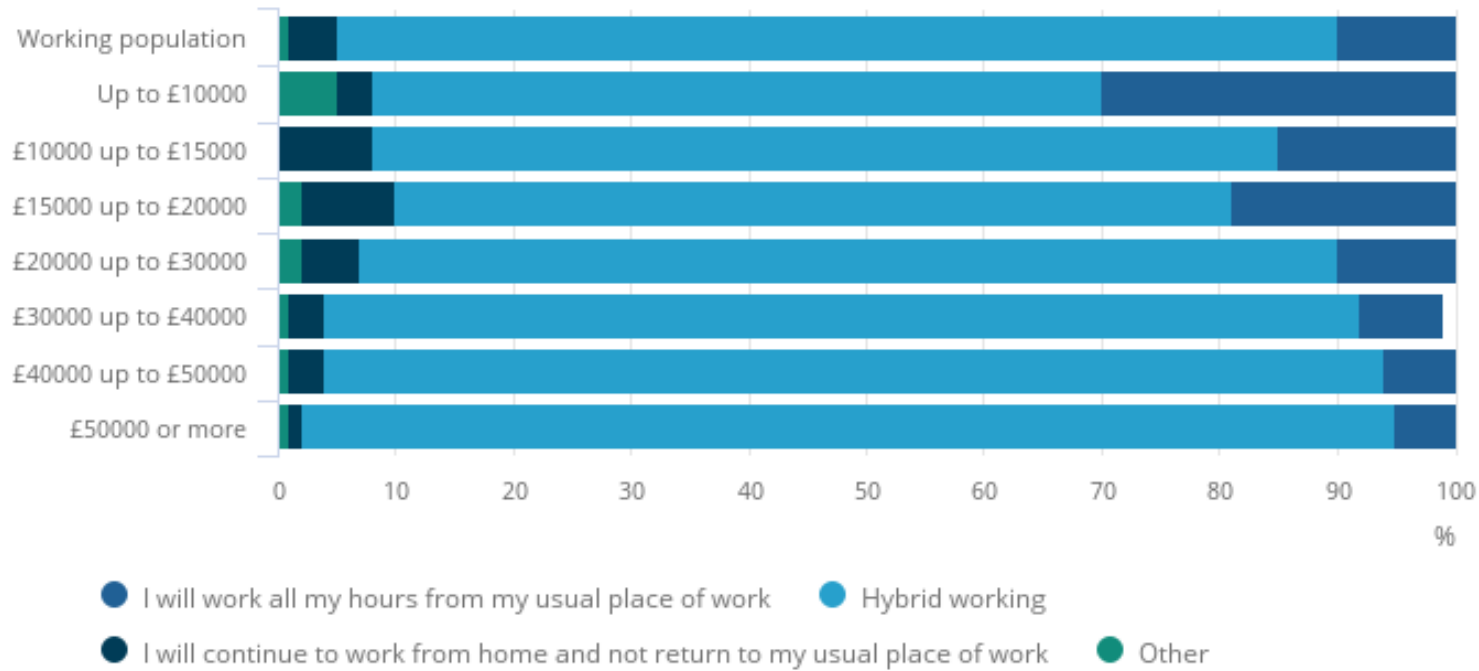




● Working remotely instead of at their normal place of work

 ● On partial or furlough leave

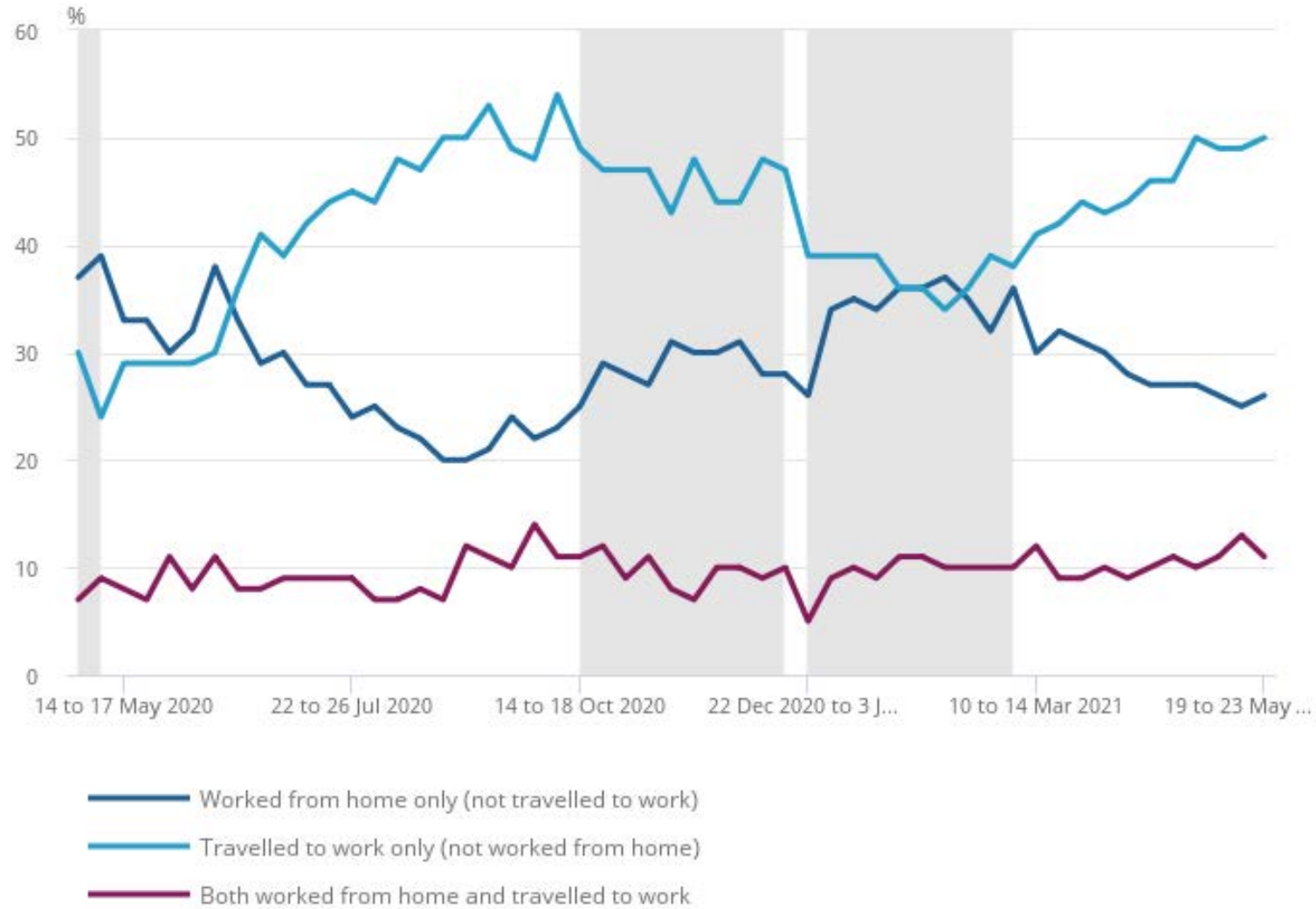
Figure 6: Those with higher incomes mostly expect a mix of homeworking and returning to their usual workplace

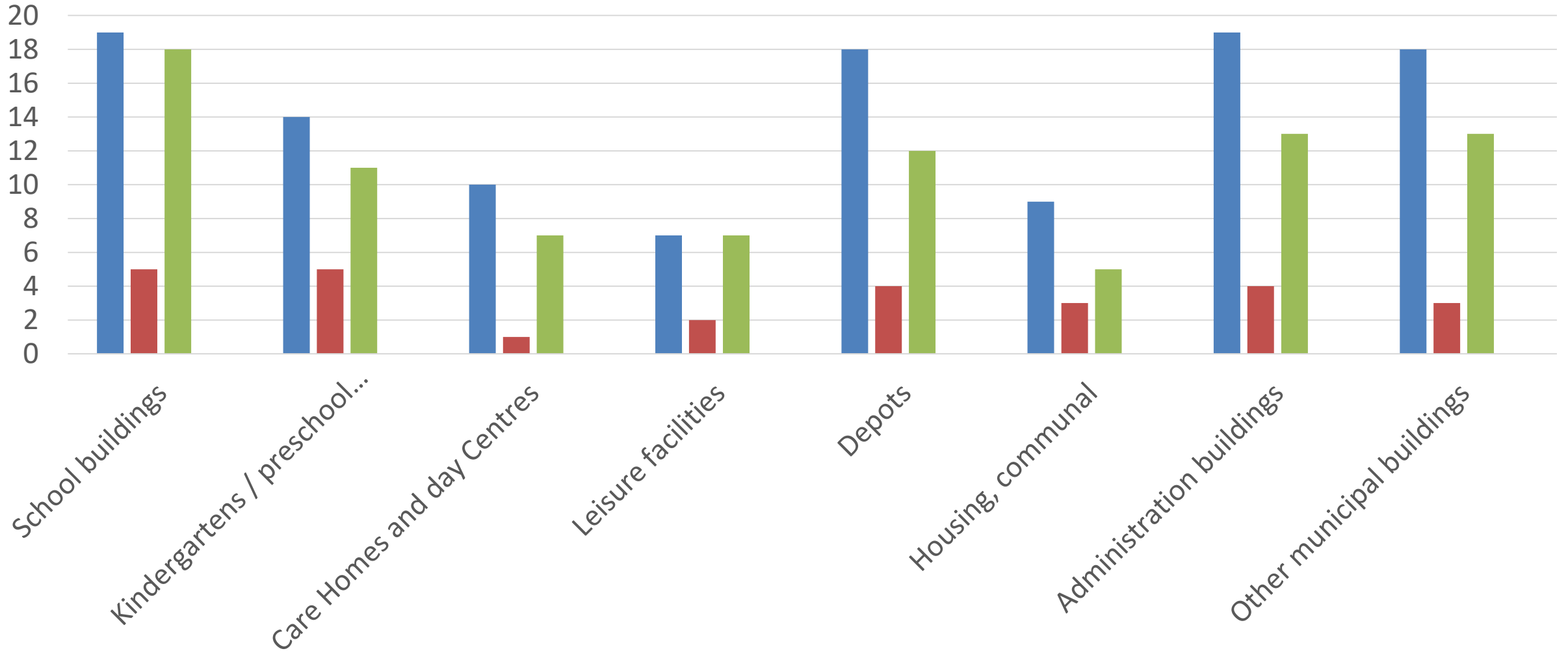
