





Climate Change Strategy:



- Our Air Quality we will improve our air quality, so it meets the World Health Organisation guidelines on air quality by 2025
- 2. Our Climate we will mitigation the impacts of climate change, so we are carbon neutral by 2030
- 3. Our Environment we will protect, enhance and maintain the borough's natural environment to improve its biodiversity value and its health and wellbeing offer.



Climate Change Strategy:



- 4. Our Sustainability we will promote a circular economy, helping to reduce waste and promote recycling, so we are recycling 65% of our municipal waste by 2030
- 5. Our Resilience we will be prepared for the impact's unavoidable climate change such as extreme weather events particularly long and intense rainfall, strong winds and storms and unusually high temperatures.

- 1 million trees!!


