#### Dear Resident

#### School Safe Haven Zone (SH03/04) - Scheme Confirmation

You may recall receiving a letter informing you of our intention to introduce a School Safe Haven Zone outside Mickleover Primary. The letter was sent to introduce you to the idea, outline its purpose and conduct some initial consultation to understand if there were any significant objections to conducting a trial.

As no significant objections were received the intention is now to proceed and introduce the Zone with a start date for the new restriction of Monday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2022.

To confirm, the Zone will be introduced on an experimental basis first. This means the new restriction will be temporary for a maximum period of 18 months. A six month period of public consultation will begin at the start and all valid objections will be considered to help decide whether or not to make the Zone permanent.

Details of how to object and engage in the consultation will be made available as regulations require by street notice and public advertisement.

#### IMPORTANT - RESTRICTION DETAILS AND EXEMPTIONS

Please read the information below to learn more about the new restriction, who can apply for an exemption and the process to follow.

#### The Restriction

A 'No Motor Vehicles' moving vehicle order will be introduced along Vicarage Road, from its junction with Park Road to its junction with Farmworth Road. The operational times of the restriction will be between 8.30 and 9.00 in the morning and 3.00 and 3.30 in the afternoon, Monday to Friday. The restriction will be applicable during school term times only and consideration will be given to the use of camera technology if compliance levels require.

You will be able to access the community centre carpark before 8.30am and can leave at any time.
