Grey fleet

What is the grey fleet?

- All the grey cars in the car park
- Cars driven by employees who are over 60
- Private cars being used for business purposes

How much does your grey fleet cost you?

- It's only 45 pence a mile!



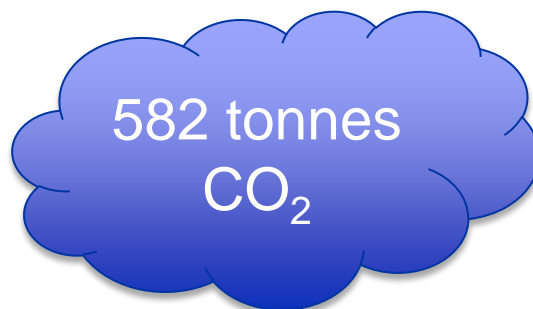
What is Grey Fleet?

- Business mileage in employee-owned vehicles
- In the public sector, evidence indicates that grey fleet makes up around 57% of total road mileage. This could add up to as much as 1.4 billion miles every year!



Key Findings –

- Worked with 13 public sector organisations
- Significant cost in allowing grey fleet
- Not just 45 pence per mile
- Emissions, H&S, cost, time, etc
- It doesn't take long to stack up!



Staff time?

- XXX staff currently spend around **46,760 hours** per year driving vehicles that are outwith the control of the organisation.
- This is equivalent to **6,234 working days** every year; or **166** full time employees driving all day, every day



Data is key

- Constantly changing environment
- Important to keep up to date
 - Licence checks
 - MOT
 - Insurance

Driving licence fines threaten two million drivers

Many drivers face a fine of £1,000 if they fail to update their photo-card driving licences, according to the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency.

It started issuing photo-card licences 15 years ago and more than 30 million drivers now have one.

These are usually valid for 10 years and there is a legal requirement for drivers to renew the photograph at the same time as they renew their licence.

However, two million drivers have failed to do this.

And this means they could be fined up to £1,000 should they be pulled over by the police, who then discover that the photo and licence is out of date.

Even failing to notify the DVLA that you have changed address could be costly.



Updating the licence is a vital legal requirement, says Victoria Ford of DVLA

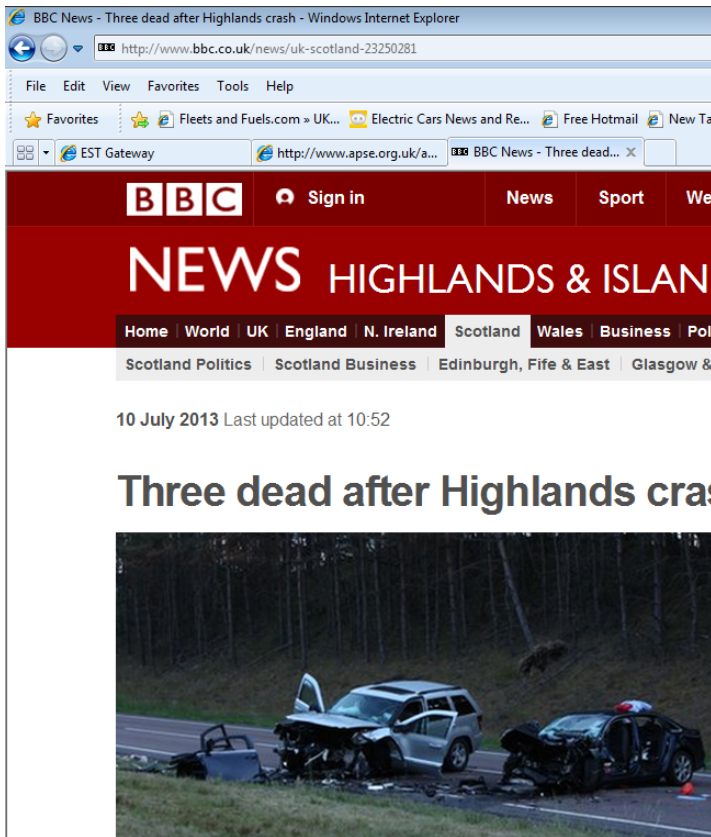

“It’s not my responsibility”

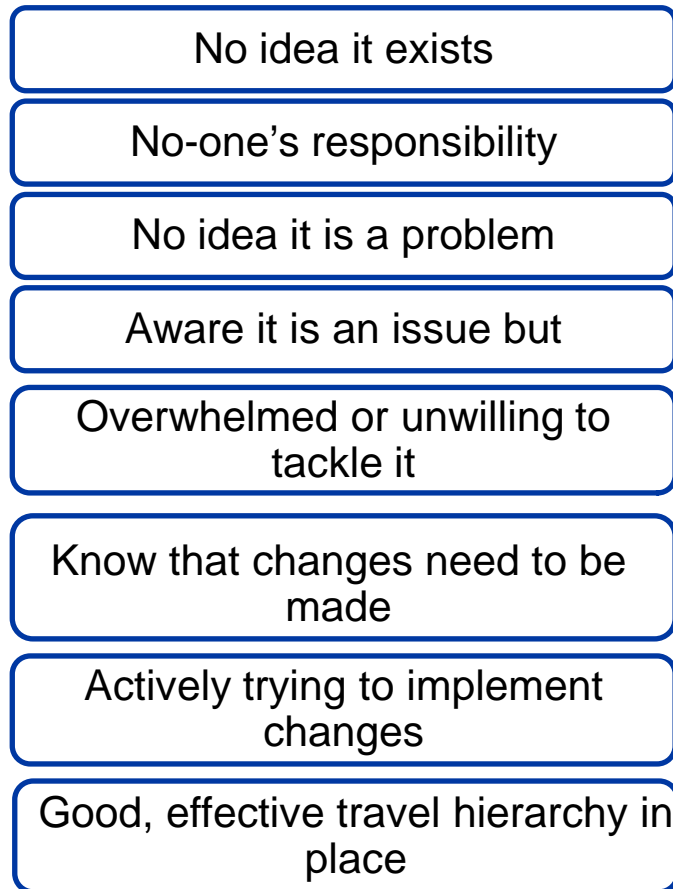
“resource to set it up and the cost of setting up and operating”

Stages of management

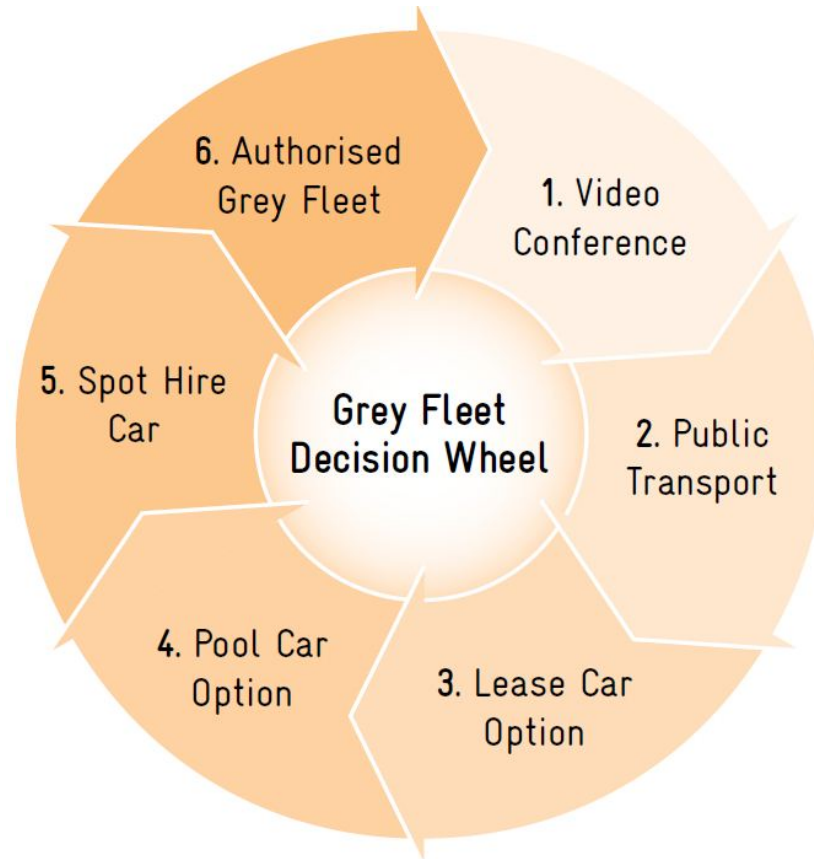


Obstacles

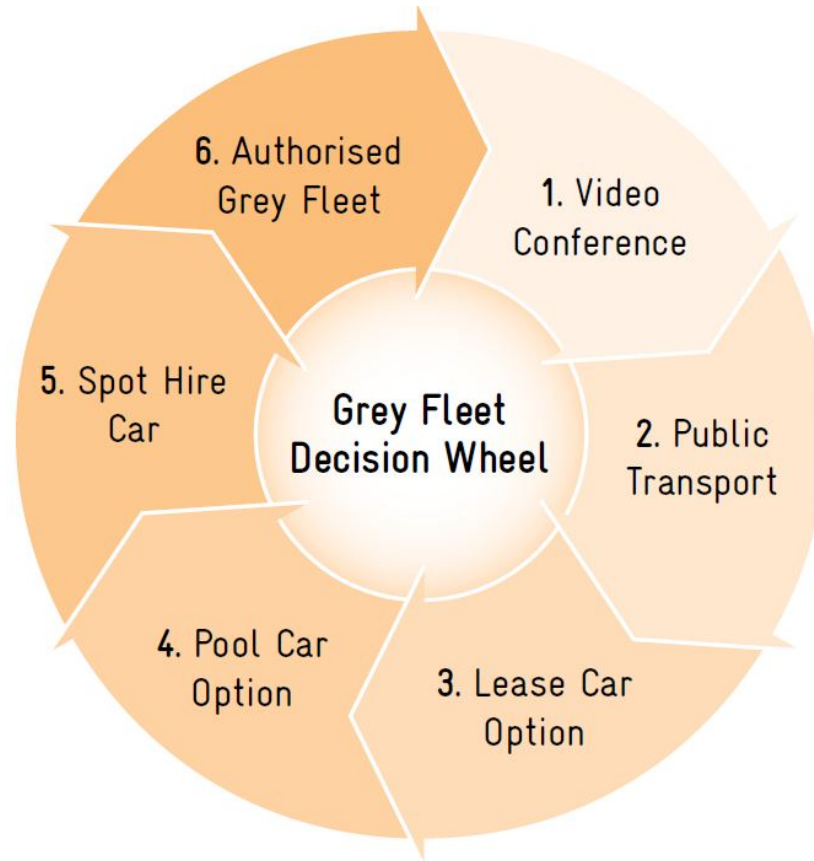

Decision making and some of the alternatives



Savings

Since 2010 Dundee University have seen an impressive 70% reduction in grey fleet miles making savings of nearly £170k

sportscotland have reduced travel by installing video-conferencing

Aberdeen City Council became members of Aberdeen car club and eliminated the Council's entire pool fleet

Dumfries & Galloway Council reduced mileage of 23% in one year; a cut from 2.86M to 2.27M miles

Cut miles – not jobs!



We are all good drivers?

- Fuel Good driver training
- 50 minutes of driver training with an ADI for £12
- Car and insurance provided
- 15% saving on fuel at time of training
