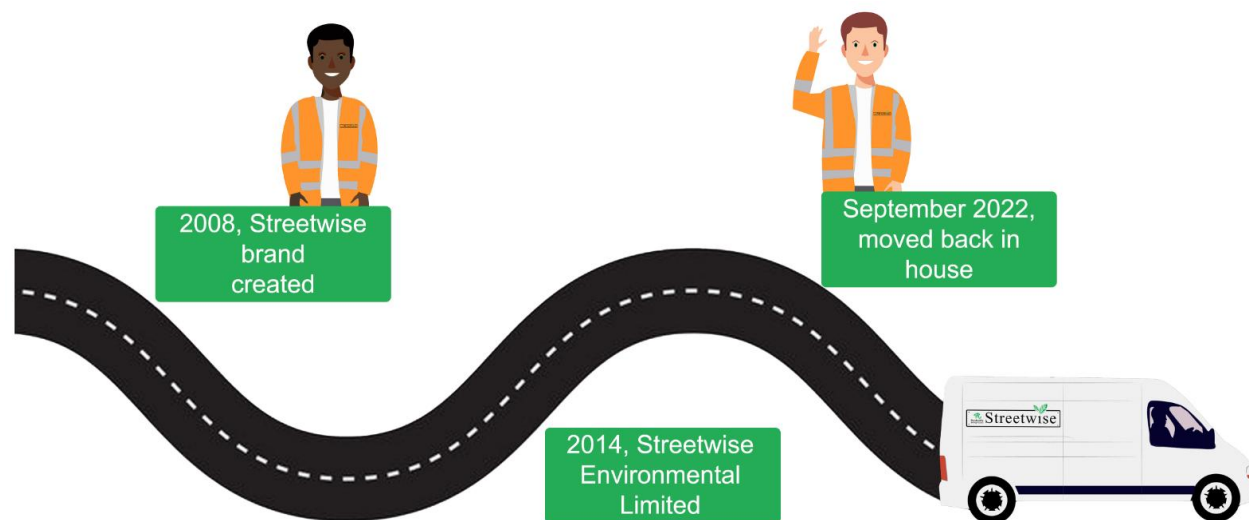


Driving Operational and Environmental Excellence:

The decision to Insource



- Full review completed by a third-party consultants in 2021.
- Cabinet report 2022 looking at possible options.
- Competitive market for Streetwise Environmental LTD to trade in.
- Loss of its biggest contract outside of Rushcliffe Prime Contract in 2019.
- Reduce bureaucracy. Streetwise Environmental had Board of Directors, Managing Director, Contract Management Team.
- Reduce the risk of council owned companies. Some high profile cases made members nervous.
- Identified £200,000 worth of savings over a 2 year period.

Stabilise

- New management structure fully embedded – roles clear, accountability strengthened.
- Customer-centric mindset adopted – service shaped around resident and user needs.

Fleet Investments and Sustainability Gains



Fleet Modernisation

- Full review of existing fleet.
- Invested £1.1 million over the last 3 years on 27 new vehicles.
- Including 2 sweepers and Versalift 4x4, 7.5 box van to increase bulky collection service.

Emissions and Fuel

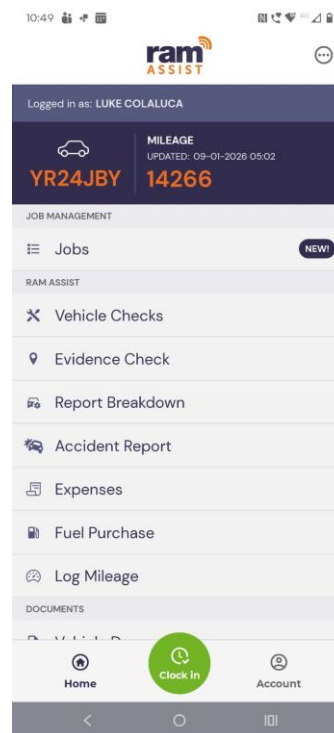
- 73% of fleet using HVO.
- Switching to HVO fuel cut emissions by 90%.
- Transition to electric equipment – blowers, hedge cutters, trimmers and chainsaws. Reduced petrol consumption by 50%.
- Positive steps towards our Carbon Neutral target 2030.



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Digital Toolkit

- Introduced app for vehicle checks and playground inspections.
- Introduced tablets for all frontline operatives.
- Created a home portal for operatives to log into to complete service sheets.
- Created Performance dashboards through PowerBi.



External Funding

- Football Foundation – set up digital inspections through Pitch Power to help monitor standards.
- Unlocked opportunity to access additional maintenance funding

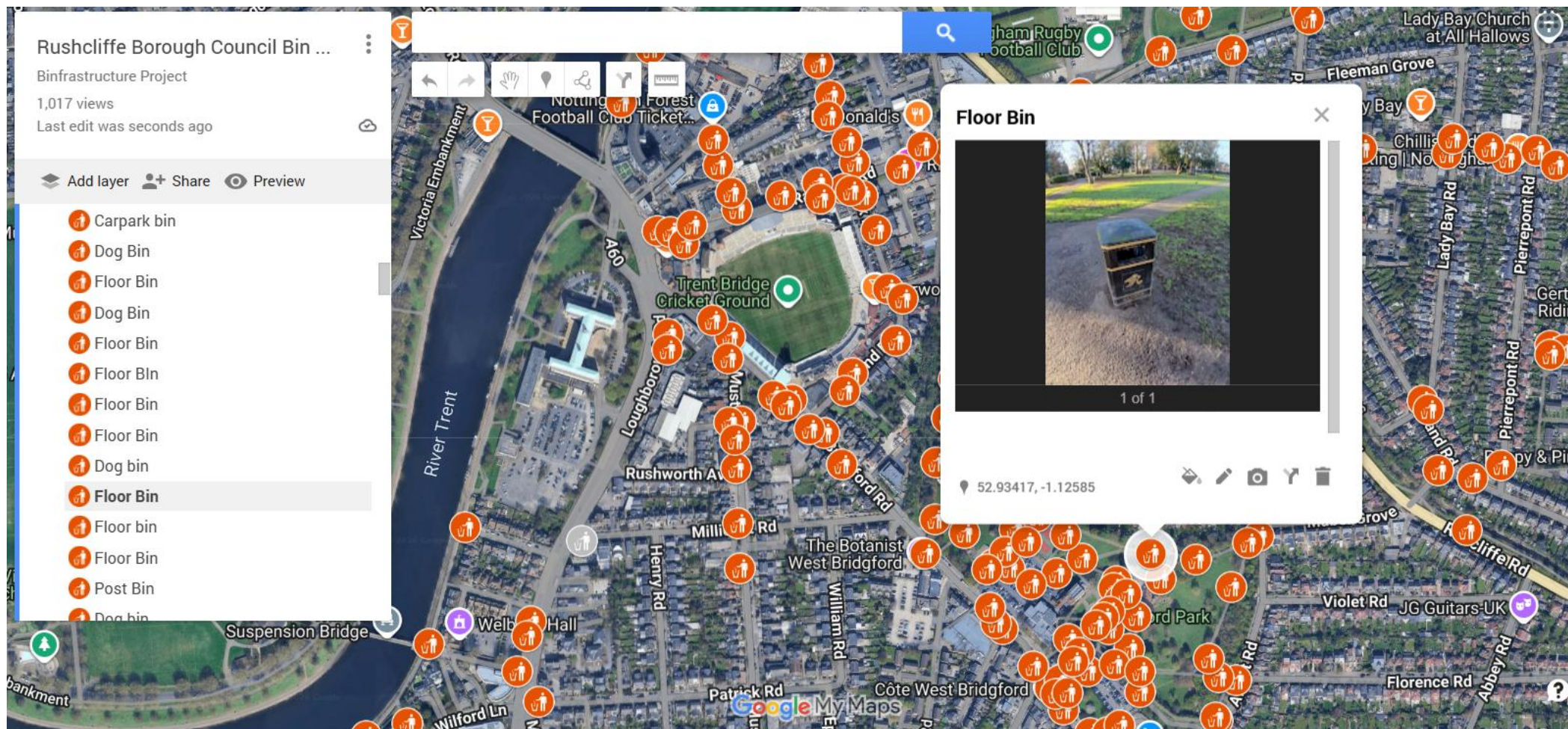
CHEWING GUM TASK FORCE

Bin-frastructure Project





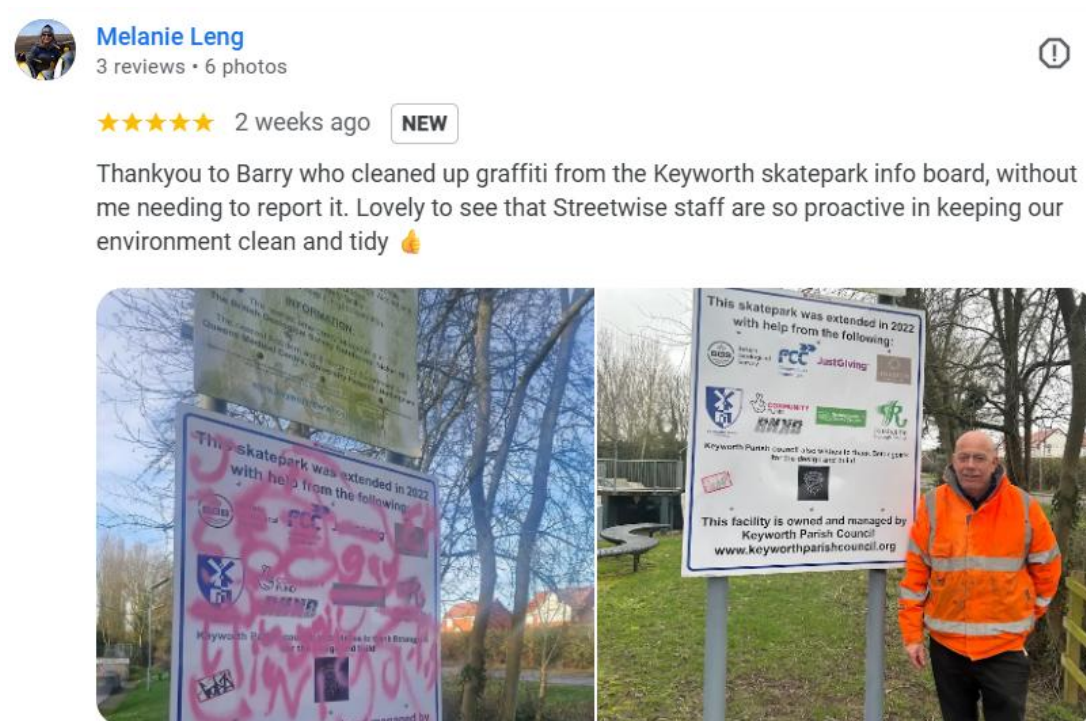
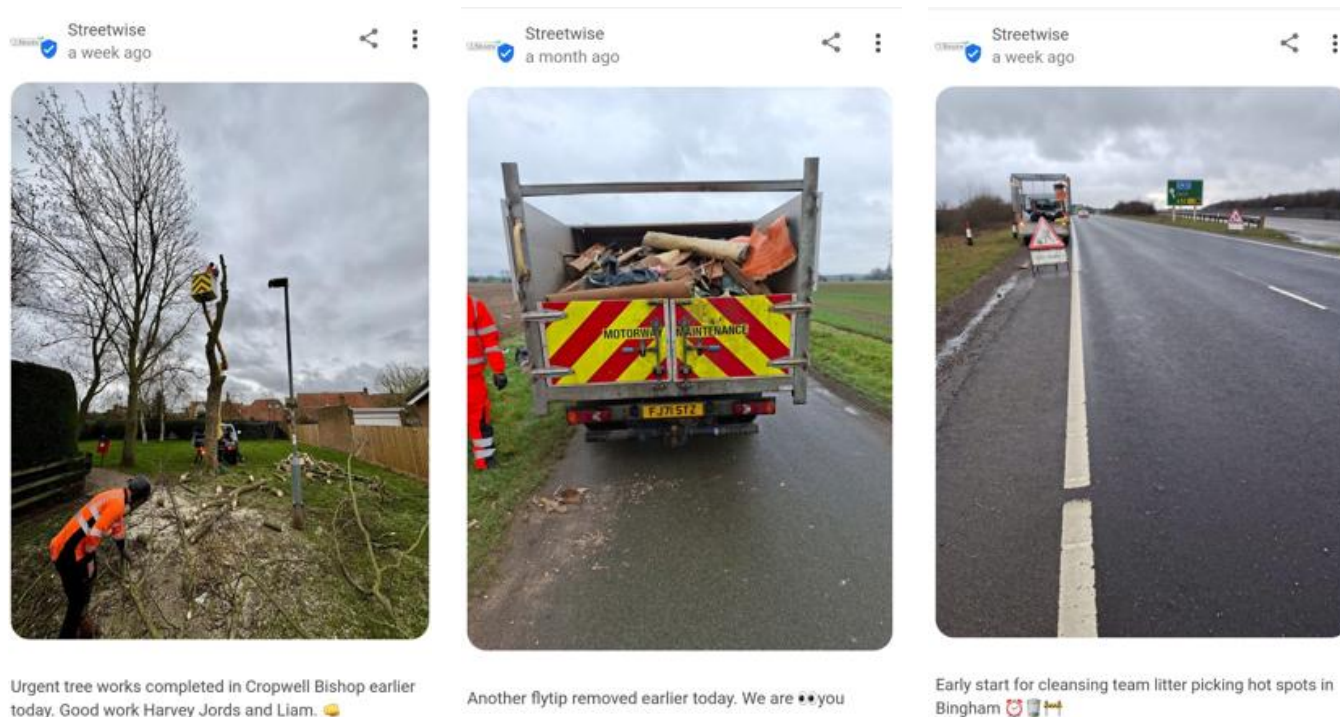
