



Free-swimming lesson provision extended to children aged between 5-10 years unable to swim 25m as part of the Council's '10 by 10' offer



Introduced 'Good Boost' sessions to help support those with musculoskeletal problems



Private sector sponsorship - extensive kids' activity programme during all school holidays with activities including skiing, golf, archery and many more.



Providing weekly inclusive Skiing, Tobogganing, Skating and Swimming sessions across the borough
