


Nine-year old from London died after asthma attack possibly linked to pollution






Figure 1: Predicted locations of exceedance of the annual mean nitrogen dioxide Limit Values without the CAP measures in Wigan in 2021





- Nearly trebling size of GMEV network to almost 1,000 charging points






Next steps


