# How can we let natural processes lead?



- Natural processes need space
- They also need all the puzzle pieces in place
- Sometimes we need to mimic natural processes through our actions.
  - Coppicing (bison and beavers)
  - Leaky dams
  - Harvesting animals
  - Sustainable forestry e.g. continuous canopy



# Degraded Landscapes – the Role of Keystone Species



- Keystone species have a disproportionate impact on ecosystems
- We now know that top predators, including the giant whales in the seas, drive ecological processes from the top of the food chain to the bottom. This is known as a trophic cascade
- Keystone species are not all predators, and trophic cascades don't always flow from top to bottom.



# Have we got the space?




Rewilding Britain are calling or 30% of Britain to be in nature recovery by 2030

- 25% semi-wild areas
