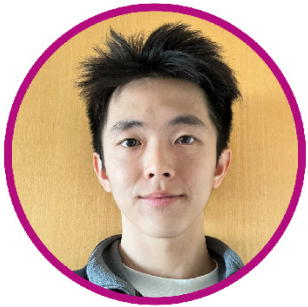
Fraser Crichton
