**Directions:** Follow the Ring Road for directions to Redbridge Park and Ride. Turn into Abingdon Road and continue past Redbridge Park & Ride all the way along the road until you reach signs saying bus and taxi entrance only. You will have to filter left into Oxpens Road. Short ways along Oxpens Road at the first set of traffic lights turn right then right again into Speedwell Street. Continue to the traffic lights at the end and turn left. You are now in St Aldate's; the Town Hall is the large building on the right at the end by the crossroads at Carfax. You will have to make a U-turn at the traffic lights at the crossroads to be able to stop outside the building.

**Parking:** No on-site parking. Oxpens Car Park, 7 minute walk. (Located on Oxpens Road next to Oxford Ice Rink, OX1 1RQ), or use of Oxford's many Park & Ride Car Parks, situated on the outskirts of the city.

Nearest Bus Station: Gloucester Green bus station, 8 minute walk

Nearest Train station: Oxford Railway Station, 13 minute walk
